We are an organization that strives to involve youth in their city government, giving them exposure to how the city is ran, giving them hands on experiences participating in different city events, as well as giving them an opportunity to voice their opinions and concerns to our city government.

With the membership of the Claremont Youth Council comes responsibility of attendance and participation in the council. We hold monthly meetings at Claremont City Hall, tentatively held the 1st Sunday of every month at 3 pm. It is imperative to the success of our council that every member attends each of these meetings. While we understand circumstances and situations beyond your control may occur, it is the member's responsibility to notify an advisor of their absence, and the reasoning behind it **before 1 pm the day of the meeting**. Members who exceed 3 **unexcused** absences will be removed from the council, and will not be recognized in further events for the council year.

Along with our meetings, we expect youth council members to take part in one of the following city committees:

- ***Claremont Planning Board**- meets the 2nd Monday of each month at 7:00 pm
- ***Parks and Recreation Committee** - meets the 4th Monday of each month at 6:00 pm
- ***Appearance Committee**- meets the 4th Monday of each month at 6:00 pm
- ***Friends of the Library**- meets the 4th Tuesday of each month at 6:00 pm

Members will serve on these committees as a youth council liaison; this allows the youth to have hands on opportunity to have an influence in our city. You are not required to attend every meeting however we encourage you to attend as many as you can, as this is an excellent way to make a difference in your community and have your voice heard.

The Claremont Youth Council also participates in several city events throughout the year that each member will be expected to attend; these events include but are not limited to *Claremont Daze, The Claremont Christmas Parade, Seniors Christmas Dinner, and the Easter Egg Hunt*.

Being involved with the Claremont Youth Council is an honor, but it also comes with a huge commitment, in order to help members plan their attendance to our meetings members will receive a packet of information at our first yearly meeting. This packet will include a calendar of event dates and times, our council's bi-laws, and our attendance policy.
