32ND ANNUAL CLAREMONT CHRISTMAS PARADE

Make plans to load up the family and head to town to enjoy the Christmas Parade and see Santa on Saturday, December 5th at 3:00 p.m. The parade route will travel along Main Street from Centennial Blvd. to North Oxford Street. This years line-up will include marching bands, beauty queens, show cars, rescue vehicles and Santa Claus. Immediately following the parade, the City Hall Council Chambers will be open for a free photo with Santa Claus, just bring your own camera!



The City of Claremont will host a Fall Festival on Saturday, November 7th on Main Street. The festivities will begin at 9:00 a.m. and continue throughout the day until 9:00 p.m. A wide variety of craft and food vendors will be present, and also free rides and activities for the kids. There will be live bands to entertain the crowd from 4:00 p.m.- 9:00 p.m. so bring a lawn chair to enjoy music!

The month of November marks the beginning of curbside leaf removal. To take advantage of this service, please rake your leaves along the curb for ease of access by the leaf vacuum. The leaves should be free of rocks and sticks, which will damage the vacuum. Please do not place leaves close to mailboxes, signs, or power poles. As a reminder, please do not block the sidewalk or drainage ditches with piles of leaves. Curbside collection will be completed during the week as time allows and continue throughout the month of January. If you prefer to bundle your leaves, clear plastic bags are required for use and are available for purchase at City Hall.
