

Because of drought conditions and low humidity, the situation in Catawba County is dangerous for any open burning. Just one spark can cause a wildfire. Please avoid parking and driving in dry grass, do not drive on a flat tire, secure safety chains coming in contact with the pavement and do not flip cigarette butts on the ground. Under current weather conditions brush fires spread faster, are harder to contain, and are far more dangerous than usual and can have the potential to cause large property loss.

Also, as a partner with the City of Hickory, we would encourage citizens to be mindful of their water consumption as the area is experiencing decreased Lake Storage levels.
