

While the budget does not call for a tax increase for the coming year, due to rising operational costs and future growth of the wastewater system the budget does call for a 2% increase on water rates and a 4% increase on sewer rates.

Just a reminder:

Grass higher than 8 inches on improved lots or 24 inches on unimproved lots is against City Ordinance. To report high grass violations please call City Hall at (828) 466 -7255. Also, it is against City Ordinance to blow grass clippings or leaves into the street. Grass clippings and leaves can cause storm drains to clog and create safety concerns and slick conditions, especially during wet weather.
