Gather up the family and head to town to enjoy the 33rd Annual Claremont Christmas Parade on Saturday, December 3rd at 3:00 p.m. The parade route will travel along Main Street from Centennial Boulevard to North Oxford Street. The line-up will include marching bands, beauty queens, show cars, Rescue, Fire and Law Enforcement vehicles, and Santa Claus. There will be vendors in the City Hall parking lot selling refreshments as well. Immediately following the parade, the City Hall Council Chambers will be open for a free photo opportunity with Santa Claus, just bring your own camera!

Loose Leaf Pickup

The month of November marks the beginning of curbside leaf removal.

To take advantage of this service, please rake your leaves along the curb for ease of access by the leaf vacuum. The leaves should be free of rocks and sticks, which will damage the vacuum.

Please do not place leaves close to mailboxes, signs, or power poles. As a reminder, please do not block the sidewalk or drainage ditches with piles of leaves. Curbside collection will be completed during the week as time allows and continue throughout the month of January. If you prefer to bundle your leaves, clear plastic bags are required for use and are available for purchase at City Hall.
